

# SUGGESTED LEARNING ACTIVITIES

## Chapter 10: Township Government

1. Invite a township supervisor to be interviewed by the class. (An agenda of questions is included in this chapter.)
2. Have students study the township grid on Page 125. Have students practice numbering a township. Then have them label a half section, quarter section and the number of acres in each.
3. Using a local county atlas, have students draw a map of the county and have them label all of the townships.
4. Have students discuss the advantages and disadvantages of dissolving townships.
